- Launched the Recovery Fund on January 9th
 - Strategic Outreach to funding partners
 - Website updated
 - Coordination with regional foundation partners
- First contribution received on January 10th - \$50K from a Foundation
- Joined LACOE Emergency Response Team
 - Served as receiving agency on behalf of LACOE
 - Partnership with Governor's Office of Emergency Services
 - Regional alignment with Pasadena and LAUSD Foundations
- First round of funds distributed on

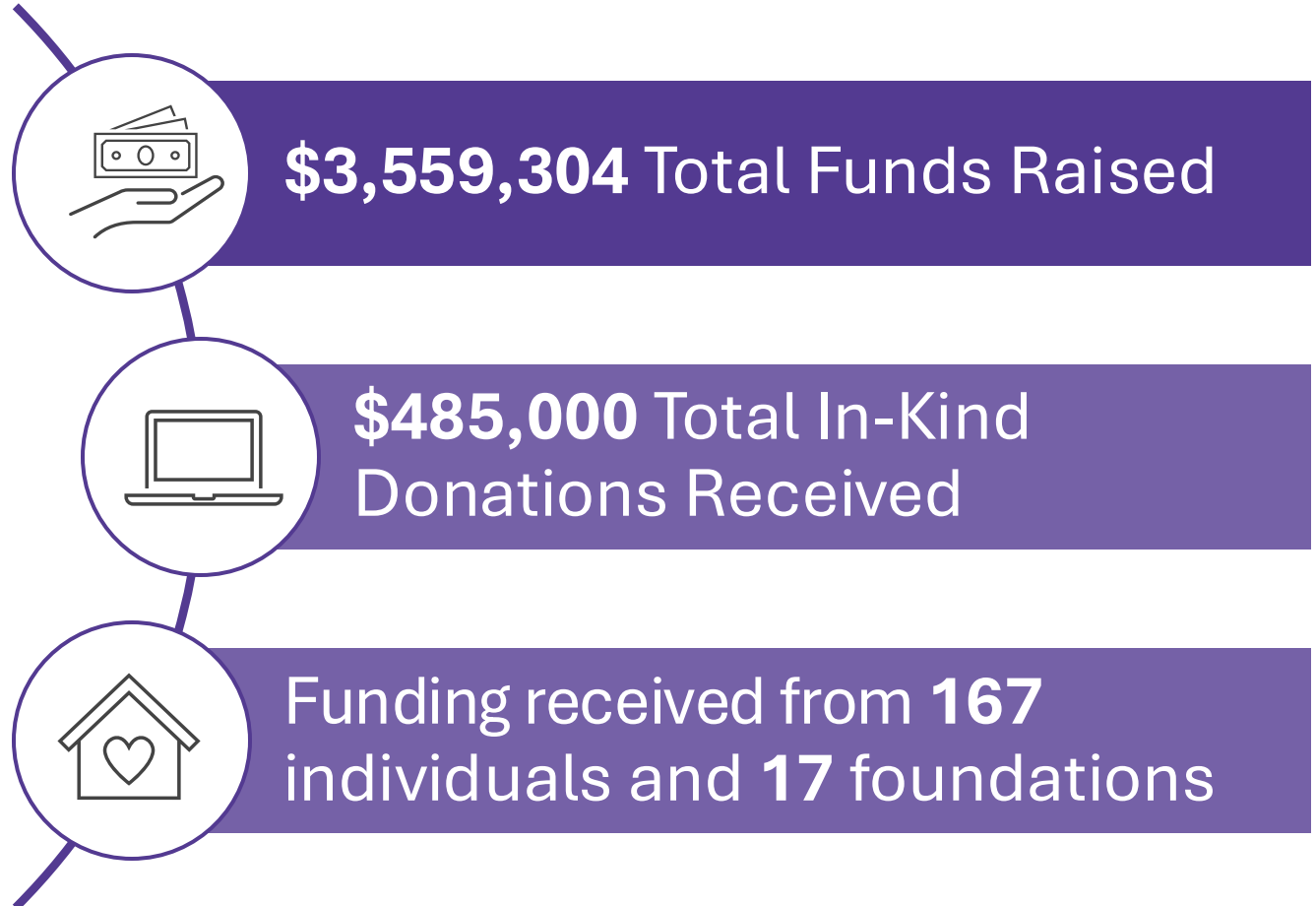

FUNDRAISING: Notable Contributions



IMMEDIATE RESPONSE TO DATE

- Basic Needs Relief
 - \$500 cash payments to 175 individuals
 - LACOE Staff
 - LACHSA Teachers and Families
 - Staff from affected LEAs, Head Start Delegate Agencies, and dedicated contractors
 - Families from affected LEAs
- Replacing and Supplementing Educational Technology
 - LACOE Technology services needs assessment
 - \$1.65M direct grant and \$485,000 in in-kind support from national partners



RECOVERY STRATEGY – Looking Ahead

 - EASE – Telehealth for staff
 - Counseling training for staff
 - Trauma Informed Resources
